In particular, I want to thank our Pastor who is the ex-officio President of the Parish Council. Reverend Nalbandanian's dedication and advice have led the Council and Church in the right direction.

This year's accomplishments will be explained in detail in Der Hyre's report. However, I am pleased to report that in 1998 the gospel message was shared with our congregation in several ways.
