In preparing this year's report, we referred to the report submitted last year to answer some questions we had and noticed that several errors were made in the reporting of the number of terms served by Parish Council members. I am attaching the pertinent pages with the noted corrections in ink and am requesting that they be inserted into last year's report and the incorrect copies removed.

It is unclear in this section of the report (section on Parish Council members) whether the Diocese is looking for the terms "serving" (when elected), or "served," as the wording indicates the past tense, but the numbers, "1st, 2nd and 3rd" indicate the present tense. Perhaps this should be clarified for next year as someone running for their third consecutive term could inadvertently be rejected according to the By-Laws if the Diocese interprets it to mean that they have completed their third consecutive term.
