

## ST. SAHAG AND ST. MESROB ARMENIAN APOSTOLIC CHURCH WYNNEWOOD, PENNSYLVANIA PARISH ASSEMBLY MINUTES

#### FEBRUARY 27, 1994

The Annual Parish Assembly was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Noubar Karagulian, Parish Council Chairman, and opened with a prayer from The Rev. Dr. Paree Metjian, Pastor.

There were 52 eligible voters when the meeting began. The number increased to 55 when voting took place.

The chairman asked for nominations for Assembly Chairman and Secretary. By a voice vote, George Devletian was elected Chairman, and Louis Karagulian, Secretary. The meeting was then turned over to the Assembly Chairman.

The Minutes of the 1993 Assembly were approved as submitted without any changes or additions.

Report of the Nominating Committee by Marie Hoplamazian, who presented the ballot and asked for nominations from the floor.

Additional names for Parish Council were: Paul Meshejian, Papken Megerian and Malena Sarrafian; Auditing Committee: Esahag Gurenlian; and Nominating Committee: Rose Arpajian.

Pastor's Report: Fr. Paree reviewed his report for 1993 stating that we must address the needs of all groups and segments of our parish, and that the theme for 1994, our 30th Anniversary, be a time for renewal and regeneration.

## Reports of Parish Council and Church Organizations:

A question regarding \$25,968 in renovations to Memorial Hall. 50% of this cost was shared by Finley Catering to remodel and convert the storage room into a reception room.

A question was asked why two (2) members of Parish Council resigned in November 1993.

A major reason was that funds raised for 1993 Armenian "Operation Winter Rescue" was directed to the HAVAD Fund for evangelistic work in Armenia. This was done against the decision of the Parish Council.

After discussions with the Primate, Pastor and Parish Council, a letter was sent to the Primate signed by the Pastor and Lisa in November 1993 asking that the funds be re-directed.

#### Sunday School:

Pamela Kitabjian asked that Yeretzgin Angel Metjian be included in the report for her help and conducting of Sunday School Assemblies during the year.

## Women's Guild Certificate Sales:

Millie Barsamian stated that the sale of certificates is a good way to raise money for the parish. It needs to be promoted to more members.

## Adoption of 1994 Budget:

After a discussion of reasons for a decline of income and suggestions for ways to increase revenue, a motion was made and passed to accept the budget showing a deficit of over \$28,000.

## New Business:

Motion made by Jovia Keytanjian; seconded by Hrant Torunyan; and passed unanimously that the Parish Council prepare and mail a survey to parishioners to stress problems, and the need for input. Council needs to act quickly upon survey's results.

#### Permanent Endowment Fund (PEF):

Kevin Leszczynski reported a Fund balance at year end of \$921,986.

Kevin asked that a vote of confidence be given to the PEF to find and present a new investment approach utilizing Mutual Funds.

#### Der Parce:

That the money raised for Armenia "Operation Winter Rescue" was redirected and will only be used for this purpose.

He stressed the need for standing permanent committees for:

1- Membership; 2 - Maintenance, and 3 - Finance.

People asked for someone to approach them in order for them to give or volunteer their services.

The feeling was that not enough credit is given for good works performed.

We accept blame for any deficiency together with parish members. A cooperative effort is needed to fulfill the needs of our parish.

The meeting was closed with a prayer at 4:30 p.m.

Եկեղեցւոյ բոլոր կազմակերպութիւնները իւրայատուկ օգտակար ծառայութիւններ մատուցանեցին, զանազան ձեռնարկներով։ Երիտասարդաց Ցանձնախումբը, ատենապետութեամբ՝ Ժան Իսկէնտերեանի եւ Տիկնանց Միութիւնը՝ առաջնորդութեամբ Տիկ Մարկրիտ Պօյաձեանի արդիւնաւոր տարի մը բոլորեցին։ Բոլոր գործադիր յանձնախումբերուն եւ անոնց անդամներուն մեր դնամատանջը։

#### PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT

1994 . . . Another Year of Progress 1995 . . . Looking to the Future

It is a pleasure to submit this annual report to the Parish Assembly as it gives me the opportunity to reflect back on what has been achieved and to look forward with a new purpose. Briefly, the following are some of the highlights of 1994:

- Every Sunday the Family of God gathered for worship and the Divine Liturgy. We have adhered to our liturgical calendar observances. A very special thanks is extended to our Choir Director, Deacons, Choir members, Organist and Acolytes for their dedication.
- The weekend of May 21st was a joyous occasion when our parish celebrated its 30th Anniversary of Consecration. His Eminence ordained to the Holy Order of Diaconate, Noubar Karagulian and Karnig Torossian. Also two dedicated members of our parish, Deacon Hagop Kitabjian and George Devletian received St. Nersess Shnorhali Medal and Encyclical from His Holiness Vazken the First. John Eskandarian received the St. Vartan Award from the Diocese. An Anniversary Banquet was held to observe these occasions. Our parish is indeed fortunate to have dedicated altar servers.
- The Sunday Church School registered 110 students of which 14 were new students. The attendance is steady among those who have set Christian Education as a priority.

In addition to classroom instruction, the Sunday School has been active with Family night dinners, the Christmas and Easter Communion/Breakfasts, a Mardi Gras Night, a Halloween Party, Project Love and Outreach for Armenia are but a few of its projects.

Upon resignation of Carol Keosayian Leszczynski and Robin Kazanjian Williams as co-superintendents, Patti Ayjian Smith was appointed as our new superintendent. She is a capable individual and hope you had the opportunity to meet her. Special thanks to Carol and Robin. And to my teaching staff, I extend my sincere appreciation for their loyalty and dedication.

- Our acolyte, incensor and reader program has been a huge success.
   Interest, participation and motivation is high. Thanks are extended to Grace Odabashian who coordinates this project..
- Young Adult Bible Fellowship has met a dire need. For more than a year, they have met on the first Thursday of each month to study the Word of God. They are a very enthusiastic group, full of potential for future growth and direction. A very special thanks to Garabed and Monique Sarkessian for their tireless efforts. All church members are welcome to attend.
- The Inter-Communal Organization was reorganized and in October it sponsored a cultural program which was held in our Memorial Hall followed by hospitality. Our representatives are: Der Paree, Armen Asdourian, Vicken Evereklian and Karnig Torossian. This year the committee will sponsor a Walkathon on April 24th.
- The preparation of Mas has been a cooperative effort. The following have contributed: Dikranuhi Degirmenci and Asdghig Kazanjian. Our sincere appreciation to them.
- Through the efforts of Leon Alyanakian, John Semerjian and Der Paree, retired Men's Fellowship was formed. Since June they have been meeting twice a month for a luncheon-social. We wish them continued success in their endeavors.
- For the first time on July 23 (Sunday) to July 29 (Friday) a summer Hrashavan was held for our youngsters at Carson Simpson Farm in Hatboro, Pa. Eighteen day campers ages 3 to 7 and 35 resident campers experienced our faith, culture and social activities. It was a huge success. Hope to do it again.

#### SACRAMENTS AND PASTORAL OUTREACH

The Parish Registry has recorded the following sacraments in 1994: Baptisms: 15; Weddings: 10; Funerals: 11.

 A total of 28 calls were made to the bereaved and aged, including hospital calls and nursing homes on a regular basis. An additional 18 house blessings were performed during the Christmas and Easter seasons upon requests.

- Some events which were initiated: Acolyte & ACYOA Jrs. Retreats;
   Relationship Enrichment Workshop; Lenten Lecture Series;
   Women's Saints Observance; Benefactors' Sunday Observance;
   Instructional Badarak, etc.
- In June our church secretary Carolyn Vail tendered her resignation. Mrs. Anie Megerian assumed secretarial duties in July. She is a capable person managing our church office and community needs. To her we extend our appreciation.
- The Mer Doon, our official church publication, has been published regularly. It has served a useful purpose in informing our members of current events in our parish life. A very special thank you to Lisa Manookian for editing the Mer Doon and Anie Megerian for typing. She is assisted by a group of volunteers addressing and mailing.

What will 1995 bring? Truly, only God knows. However, there are signs that this will be an exciting year filled with great possibilities. Let us consider a few:

- In March we will have the ACYOA Jrs. retreat at Newman Camp. In March the Acolytes will hold their own retreat at Camp Sankanack. It is hoped that these retreats will strengthen leadership qualities within our young people.
- During the Lenten Season, we will sponsor a lecture series every Friday by the Armenia Outreach Committee and the Tekeyan Cultural Association. The topics will center on issues facing the future of our community and challenges facing Armenia.
- Efforts are underway to re-organize Young Couples Fellowship. An executive committee has been formed to initiate few programs headed by Arlet Zeibari. Young couples are urged to participate.
- As a Christian community, it was our responsibility to extend goodwill beyond our parish walls. We plan to sponsor "Feed the

Homeless" quarterly visits to institutions by our youth and interested families. Watch for details.

- The Community Telephone Directory will be ready sometime in April. It will include help hints, addresses, phone numbers and business and professional listings. It will be a helpful tool to keep a friendship alive!
- From time to time we are asked to respond to appeals for urgent causes for Armenia. I know church members would participate whenever possible. Through the Diocese we are asked to participate in the "National Endowment" with an annual donation of one's choosing. The money will be used to strengthen the infrastructure. Your participation is important in this matter.
- Our community has multifaceted needs that demand our attention: Sunday School; the youth (teens & adults); married couples and the Senior Citizens. In every area, we need people to carry on the challenge. When members are reluctant to get involved, these needs will continue to be ignored.
- This summer one week summer "Hrashavan" camp will take place at Carson Simpson Farm, Hatboro, PA. For one week, children ages 3 to 7 as day campers and 8 to 12 as resident campers will learn about our Faith, Culture and participate in social activities.
- Outreach Mission 95 is being planned for our college youth. A
  group made up from our parish will spend two weeks in Armenia,
  visiting orphanages, families of war victims and parishes.
- On a personal note, 1995 will be a milestone in my ministry. It was 25 years ago on June 7th, that I was ordained to the Holy Order of Priesthood, by His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian. The last 10 years as your pastor. I feel honored that my church will observe the anniversary.

As pastor, I've learned that it is impossible to accomplish anything worthwhile without the help of church members. In every phase of our church operation, there are loyal members who assume the task and play a supportive role while many others are hesitant to get involved. To run this church effectively, I need your help!

Let's reaffirm our partnership that exists, carrying on Christ's mission in the years to come.

- 1995 promises to be another exciting year. We will reach out to all those who are craving for spiritual direction--Baptisms, Weddings, shut-ins, Christian nurture for the young generation and social fellowship.
- In conclusion, I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt appreciation to Papken Megerian, chairmen of the Parish Council, for his leadership, cooperation and advice. Also, I wish to thank members of the Parish Council, Diocesan Delegates, executive committees of each organization and supportive members. In fact, without you, there will be no church.

With your help, we hope to continue this upward trend. Progress should be measured not only by the physical improvement, but more importantly, by the lives that are changed through the support of the church's mission to her members and non-members.

It is my hope that together we can serve the Lord in new and creative ways. There is no doubt that 1995 will be another successful year, with everyone being a part of our success.

- Following the General Assembly, the Parish Council met with all church organizations. The purpose was to create a closer relationship between the active bodies of the church.
- On Sunday, March 27th, the A.C.Y.O.A. Jrs. held their annual Palm Sunday Banquet and honored Mr. & Mrs. Papken Megerian.
- The Women's Guild and Men's Club co-sponsored the annual Dinner/Dance on Friday April 9th. As in the past, this year they hosted the Christmas and the Easter Communion/Breakfasts for our Sunday School. Our sincere appreciation is extended.
- On Sunday, April 17th, the Parish Council hosted our first Art Auction. Many thanks to the Chairman Mr. Hrair Megerian and his committee for this successful fund-raising event.
