#### ST. SAHAG AND ST. MECROB ARMENIAN CHURCH PARISH ASSEMBLY MINUTES FERUARY 12, 1995

The Annual Parish Assembly was opened at 1:00 pm with a prayer by Reverend Dr. Paree Metjian, Pastor and President of the Assembly.

<u>Verification of Eligible Voters:</u> Fifty-four eligible members registered, at which time they received an official ballot.

Election of Assembly Officers: George Devletian welcomed those in attendance and then asked for nominations for Assembly Chairman and Secretary. Elected were George Devletian as Chairman, and Malena Sarrafian as Secretary.

Election of Parish Council, Auditing and Nominating Committees: The Nominating Committee representative, Rose Arpajian, asked if there were additional nominations from the floor for any of these positions. There being no additional names submitted, nominations were closed. Each candidate was introduced to the assembly, and voting was the next order of business. Ballots were cast as each eligible member's name was read from the registration book. Mrs. Arpajian requested that Alice Arakelian and Harry Amirian assist in counting the ballots, along with Shant Kehyayan representing the Auditing Committee. It was moved the balloting be closed. Motion carried.

Minutes of 1994 Assembly: Minutes of the 1994 Assembly were approved with the following corrections:

- 1. Under the Section entitled, "Reports of Parish Council and Church Organizations," Paragraphs 2-4 shall be stricken.
- 2. And the following shall be inserted: "Harry Arakelian asked why two (2) members of the Parish Council resigned in November of 1993.

Lisa Manookian was asked to respond. She told the Assembly that the main reason for her resignation was that funds raised for Operation Winter Rescue, in early 1993, were misdirected to the HAVAD Mission Project by the Pastor.

Lisa summarized and informed the Assembly of how everything transpired. She also stated that upon informing the Parish Council, a letter was sent to the Diocese, signed by the Pastor and Lisa as Chairperson, requesting that the monies be re-directed, which they were.

Lisa concluded by stating that she felt she had an obligation to bring the incident to the Assembly's attention because she feared that withholding knowledge of the incident would have been a betrayal on her part and that public awareness of soliciting funds for one purpose and utilizing them for another could weaken future efforts to solicit funds for Armenia"

Pastor's and Organization Reports: It was moved that these reports not be read aloud. Motion approved by show of hands. The Pastor's and Parish Council Reports were accepted as written. There was some discussion regarding the ACYOA Seniors organization and its activities as a group. The Men's Club financial statement was questioned, which brought about the discussion of dates reserved for Memorial Hall to accommodate their Annual Dinner Dance. There was some discussion regarding the Food Certificate program sponsored by the Women's Guild, and Millie Barsamian explained the process and benefits. Mr. Garo Avesian, Vice-Chairman of the Armenian Outreach Committee spoke on their behalf, expressing their gratitude for the support and encouragement they have received, and that they hope to grow with the community. All of the organization reports were accepted as written.

Adoption of the 1995 Budget: Treasurer, David Nalbantian, presented the proposed budget for 1995. A motion was made and seconded to leave the clergy stipend at the 1994 actual amount of \$44,869. The motion was defeated. A motion was made and seconded to adopt the proposed budget for 1995 in the amount of \$253,771. Motion passed.

<u>Permanent Endowment Fund:</u> Kevin Leszcynski, Chairman of PEF, presented its financial report and was available to answer questions. The report was accepted with appreciation.

New Business: There had been a proposal to ask the assembly to move on a request that an ad-hock committee be formed to review the structure of the PEF. However, the Parish Council Chairman reported he had been informed by Steve Barsamian that a motion would not be necessary, and that the Parish Council would be within its rights to create any committee to review any church organization.

There was some discussion regarding our church dues and membership compared to other churches in the Diocese. The breakdown of our assessment of dues to the Diocese was explained by Papken Megerian. He also stated the Parish Council would welcome any suggestions or comments regarding dues.

The status of the Armen Ounjian Fund was questioned. George Devletian explained the purpose of the fund and that he has been the representative from our church for the fund since George Mangigian moved away. The fund has \$45,000 and it has had requests as recently as 6 months ago.

A request was made that a report be given to the next assembly of the attendance record of Parish Council members to their meetings.

George Devletian informed the assembly that our church would host the 1996 Diocesan Assembly, and that the committee would be asking for assistance in various capacities - please be available to help.

Upcoming is the 25th Anniversary celebration of Der Paree's ordination into the priesthood. This committee too, would be asking for assistance.

Der Paree also commented that this is one of the best Parishes in our Diocese. He stated that with all of our shortcomings and our challenges, there still is a spirit that must be harnessed in this Parish. He further stated we have to work together and make this Parish an exemplary and God pleasing Parish.

The meeting was closed with a prayer and adjourned at 3:45 pm.

Տէր Հօր ՔաՀանայական Ձեռնադրութեան 25րդ տարեդարձի Հանդիսութիւնը տեղի ունեցաւ, Կիրակի, Յունիս 4, 1995-ին, Թեմիս Առաջնորդ Սրբագան Հօր Հովանաւորութեամբ եւ Ծիական ԽորՀուրդի նախաձեռնութեամբ։ Հանդիսաւոր Պատարադէ վերջ տեղի ունեցաւ ճաչկերդյթ եւ յատուկ յայտադիր մը։ Խորին չնորՀակալութիւն Յակոր Սրկ Քիթապձեանին որ վարեց ատենապետի եւ օրուայ Հանդիսավարի զոյգ պաչտօնները, ինչպէս նաեւ Ցանձնախումբի բոլոր անդամներուն։ Իմ կեանջիս մէջ այդ օրը պիտի մնայ անմուանալի օր մը։

#### PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT

1995 . . . Another Year of Progress 1996 . . . Looking to the Future

I hope this annual pastoral report will find you in the afterglow of a blessed Christmas season as well as looking ahead expectantly to the new year of 1996. Let us trust that the Lord has wonderful plans for all of us in the next twelve months.

Looking back, 1995 has been a year with various successful activities. Spiritually speaking, the Divine Liturgy was celebrated every Sunday. Under the capable leadership of Noubar Karagulian, our choir director, along with the organist, choir members, deacons and acolytes they render an inspiring service and we have adhered to our liturgical calendar.

During the Lenten Season, "Hskoom" service was held every Friday, followed by a dinner sponsored by the Armenia Outreach Committe and Tekeyan Cultural Association. The dinners were followed by guest speakers whose topics were based on themes of spiritual, cultural, historical and national subjects; these lectures were well received.

Sunday Church School registered another successful year. As always, Septembery till January are considered months with peak attendance, thereafter, attendance drops. Parents must consider spiritual growth of their children a top priority. Along with classroom instructions, Sunday School sponsors an orphan in Armenia, Mardi Gras, Family Night, Christmas and Easter Communion breakfasts. Also, they present an annual Christmas pageant to the delight of the congregation. This year's committee members were: Pam Kitabjian, Yeretzgin Angel Metjian, Linda Barsamian and Alicia Dakerian Craig as the artistic coordinator. Our sincere thanks to Adienne Riser, Linda Babikian and Patti Smith the acting coordinators of our Sunday School for 1995-96.

As a service project, our acolytes, incensors and readers' program has been a huge success. Our thanks to Anie Megerian and RoseEllen Campbell for coordinating this project.

 ACYOA Jrs. were active with several social and fund raising activities. Present chairperson, Alexis Seropian, along with the Executive Committee have sponsored several activities. Sincere appreciation to John Eskandarian for acting as our Youth Advisor.

- To promote closer cooperation, Der Hayr attended periodic Armenian clergy and Wynnewood Ministerium meetings.
- The Inter-Communal Organization was reorganized and in October it sponsored a cultural program which was held in our Memorial Hall. Our representatives are: Der Paree, Armen Asdourian, Viken Evereklian and Karnig Torossian.
- Our auxiliary church organizations render useful service to their respective members. To all executive committee members we extend our appreciation. Our newest organization, the Retired Men's Fellowship meets twice a month for luncheon and social. We wish them continued success in their endeavors.
- An attractive Community Telephone Directory was published in 1995, with the assistance of Araxie Richards and Grant Mazmanian. Thanks to all the businesses that supported this project.

#### PASTORAL/OUTREACH/ADMINISTRATIVE

The Parish Registry has recorded the following sacraments in 1995: Baptisms: 14; Weddings: 8; Funerals: 10.

- A total of 28 calls were made to the bereaved and aged, including visits to hospitals and nursing homes on a regular basis. An additional 22 house blessings were performed during the Christmas and Easter seasons upon requests.
- Some events which were initiated: Acolyte & ACYOA Jrs. Retreats; Relationship Enrichment Workshop; Lenten Lecture Series; Women Saints Observance; Benefactors' Sunday Observance; Instructional Badarak, etc.
- For more than a year, Mrs. Anie Megerian has assumed the secretarial duties of our church. She has shown excellent secretarial skills in managing our church office. To her we extend our sincere appreciation.

- The Mer Doon, our official church publication, has been published regularly. It has served a useful purpose in informing our members of current events in our parish life. A very special thank you to Lisa Manookian for editing the Mer Doon and Anie Megerian for typing. She is assisted by Araxie Richards and Noubar Karagulian in addressing and mailing.
- To commemorate the Pastor's 25th Anniversary of Ordination to the Holy Order of Priesthood, two people from our parish travelled to Armenia. The purpose of the visit was to extend a helping hand to the orphans, clergy, and families of deceased freedon fighters. We have returned with cherished memories. Shamiram Dokmanian, Der Paree and Louisa Paronyan's trips were financed by the Human Resources Fund.

In 1995 the following outreach donations were made for Armenia: Dr. Radik Martirosian \$500.00; Kandzasar Publishing \$1,200.00 St. Tarkmanchatz School in Jerusalem \$500.00.

What will 1996 bring? Truly, only God knows. However, there are signs that this will be an exciting year filled with great possibilities. Let us consider a few:

- In March we will have the ACYOA Jrs. retreat at Newman Camp and the Acolytes will hold their own retreat at Camp Sankanac. It is hoped that these retreats will strengthen leadership qualities within our young people.
- This year again during Lent "Hskoom" services will take place every Friday, followed by dinner and lecture series. Our appreciation to Tekeyan Cultural Association for hosting the dinners and some of the programs.
- This past October, the Parish Council initiated an "Open Forum," to exchange ideas for the betterment of our parish. We anticipate that a few projects will be initiated and we need your participation. One idea which will be acted upon will be adult education. During the Lenten season on Sundays, a series of spiritual lectures will take place. Watch for details.
- As a Christian community, it was our responsibility to extend goodwill beyond our parish walls. We are happy to inform you that the

ACYOA Jrs. initiated a project "Feed the Homeless." Another visit will take place in March.

- Our community has multifaceted needs that demand our attention: Sunday School; the youth (teens & adults); married couples and the senior citizens. In every area, we need people to carry on the challenge. When members are reluctant to get involved, these needs will continue to be ignored.
- For the second time in the history of our parish, we will be hosting the Annual Diocesan Assembly in May. More than 200 clergy, lay delegates and visitors are expected to attend. Volunteer to help.
- Plans are underway to sponsor a camp program at Carson Simpson Farm in July as day a and resident camp. The purpose being to reach out to our youngsters at an early age.

As pastor, I've learned that it is impossible to accomplish anything worthwhile without the help of church members. In every phase of our church operation, there are loyal members who assume the task and play a supportive role while many others are hesitant to get involved. To run this church effectively, I need your help! Let's reaffirm our partnership that exists, carrying on Christ's mission in the years to come.

• In conclusion, I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt appreciation to Papken Megerian, chairman of the Parish Council, for his leadership, cooperation and advice. Also, I wish to thank members of the Parish Council, Diocesan Delegates, executive committees of each organization and supportive members. In fact, without you, there will be no church.

It is my hope that together we can serve the Lord in new and creative ways. There is no doubt that 1996 will be another successful year, with everyone being a part of our success.

#### REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL.

This past year has been exceptional for our parish and we have much to give thanks for. The Parish Council met twice a month and council members were involved in supporting many church projects. They diligently carried out the mission of the church, the financial challenges and the maintenance of our huge complex. In 1995, the spirit of community and working towards the greater glory of our Lord and His people were particularly evident. Below are some of the highlights of these efforts:

Armenian Christmas Breakfast: On Saturday, January 7th, our Men's Club hosted their traditional brunch for the Sunday School students and staff.

Palm Sunday ACYOA Day Banquet: On Sunday, April 9, our ACYOA Jrs. and Youth Committee sponsored the Annual Palm Sunday Banquet, honoring one of our parish's most dedicated members: Victoria Sagherian.
