ST. SAHAG AND ST. MESROB ARMENIAN CHURCH PARISH ASSEMBLY MINUTES

February 11, 1996

The Annual Parish Assembly was opened with prayer by The Reverend Dr. Paree Metjian, Pastor and President of the Assembly.

<u>Verification of Eliqible Voters</u>: Sixty-nine (69) eligible members registered and received official ballots. Sixty-seven (67) members voted.

Election of Assembly Officers: George Devletian welcomed those in attendance and asked for nominations for Assembly Chairman and Secretary. By acclimation, Bruce Ballard was elected chairman and Betty Boyajian, secretary.

Minutes of the 1995 Assembly were approved as corrected. A recommendation was made that the format of the Parish Assembly Annual Report be revised for two reasons:

- (1) When 8½" x 11" pages were reduced to fit pages in the booklet, the type was reduced in size and difficult to read;
- (2) Collating, folding and stapling the 5½" x 8½" booklet was time consuming.

It was suggested the size of future Parish Assembly Annual Reports be $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11". The Parish Council will consider the suggestion.

Election of Parish Council members, Diocesan Delegates,
Nominating and Auditing Committee members: Aram Fayda,
Nominating Committee Chairman asked for additional nominations
for each category. Charles Keytanjian was added as a candidate for Parish Council, and withdrew his name from the Nominating Committee list. There being no other additions, nominations were closed. The candidates present were introduced to the Assembly. Ballots were cast as each member's name was read from the registration book.

Pastor's Report: Der Paree reviewed his report in Armenian and English. He made special mention of how successful the Outreach Committee's activities were during the year, and urged that they be encouraged by supporting their endeavors to serve the church and the community.

Eligible members who arrived late were permitted to vote. The ballot box was closed, and the Nominating Committee retired to another room to count ballots.

There was an intermission for lunch.

"The Parish Council would like to take this opportunity to thank Dearon Mazmanian, Maintenance Coordinator, who took care of our . . . "

Financial Report: A question was raised regarding salary to the church organist, which is not reflected in the budget for 1995. The Treasurer stated that the organist is given a \$25.00 Honorarium per Sunday. This is not considered salary, and is included in Miscellaneous Expenses in the budget. Discussion followed. It was recommended that future budgets contain a line item for Organist and Organ Lessons.

A motion was made and seconded to increase the salary for Office Secretary. During the discussion period which followed, it was explained that the Parish Council has a formula for salary increases for all employees. The motion was defeated.

At the previous Parish Assembly, the cost of clergy health insurance was raised. The Parish Council was asked to research other health plans to see if there was one - similar to that of the Diocese - which would be less expensive. After a thorough study of other health plans, it was agreed that the Pastor would obtain his own health insurance, for which he is reimbursed by the Parish Council. The cost of this insurance is less than that offered by the Diocese.

- Hayatian Hall Janitorial Expenses. This figure is for clean-up after outside rentals. However, individuals who rent the Hall are charged a clean-up fee, in addition to the rental fee, to compensate for the janitorial expenses. This procedure is also true for Memorial Hall.
- ACYOA Computer Fund. The total figure of \$2460.00 is the balance remaining after the two computers were purchased for the church. The Fund was created from the profit realized when our ACYOA hosted the Diocesan ACYOA Convention a few years ago.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to accept the budget of \$250,800.00 for calendar year 1996.

Reports of Church Organizations

Permanent Endowment Fund: The Report for 1995 (copy attached) was circulated by members of the Committee. Kevin Leszczynski, Chairman of the Executive Body, explained the Report and asked for comments. There are presently six separate funds within the Permanent Endowment Fund, with a value of \$1,081,199.00, as of 12/31/95.

The Asset Allocation for most of the individual funds are invested: 50% in CD's, 25% Domestic Growth, 25% International Growth. There is a Permanent Endowment Fund in Lieu of Flowers

in a Savings Account, which will be added to the Core Fund, for better interest income and to increase the Principal.

The PEF Committee is considering a change in the distribution schedule. If there is at least a 25% increase in the value of the Mutual Fund Accounts, the funds transferred to the Parish Council would be adjusted, accordingly, to share the growth. The Principal would be preserved.

A tribute for a job well-done was extended to Kevin who will complete his 7-year term, three as Chairman, with the PEF. He has, however, agreed to be available as a financial consultant.

Choir: It was noted that our Choir received the Gomidas Award for excellence, at the 1995 Choir Convention. Congratulations!

Youth Committee: Since most of the current members do not have young children, it was requested that parents of preteenage children be encouraged to work with the Youth Committee in its many endeavors.

A special "Thank You" was given to John Eskandarian for his untiring contribution as Acting Youth Director, among his many services to the church.

Women's Guild Certificate Report: Since its inception, over \$20,000.00 in profit has been turned over to the Parish Council. Future Annual Reports will include the value of certificates on hand, as well as the cash balance.

The Assembly expressed appreciation for the work of the church organizations.

Auditing Committee: As of this date, auditing the books of the General Fund and all but two of the organizations had been done. Recommendations will be submitted to the Parish Council when the auditing is completed.

Report of Ad Hoc Committee on Revision of PEF By-Laws:

- Question: Can the Parish Council Chairman be an Ex-Officio member of the PEF? The Parish Council Chairman is an Ex-Officio member of all church organizations.
- Question regarding submission of names for the PEF: Names of candidates for the PEF must be submitted to the PEF Committee before the end of a calendar year. Anyone may make a recommendation, including Parish Council. However, names for membership are referred by the PEF to the Parish Council, which makes the final approval.
- Question: Can interest money in Camp Ground Fund #1 be touched? The interest is growing. After a careful review by the Parish Council and the PEF Committee, a proposal will be presented at a future Parish Assembly.

Proposal to Change Date of Parish Assembly: It was reccommended that the date of the Parish Assembly be changed to a Sunday in the Fall, because many parishioners take winter vacations. Discussion followed. The budget would have to be prepared before the end of the year, and financial information would be estimated. It would not be the same information submitted to the Diocese, which operates on a calendar year.

The recommendation was put to a motion, seconded.

Progress Report on Diocesan Assembly, April 29-May 5, 1996, was given by George Devletian, Co-chairman of the Committee. He briefly outlined the schedule of events, and encouraged parishioners to respond favorably to requests for contributions to the Commemorative Assembly Booklet.

All Reports were accepted with thanks.

New_Business:

- Office Security: The design of the church office makes it difficult for the secretary to see people enter until they are at the inner-office door. The Parish Council is aware of the situation, and is looking into ways to tighten security throughout the entire church complex.
- It was suggested that voting or at least the announcement of election results - be at the end of the meeting, so that members will remain and contribute to the other business of the Agenda. The Parish Council will consider this suggestion.
- A recommendation was made to lower annual dues in order to increase dues-paying membership. A motion was made and seconded authorizing the incoming Parish Council to study the dues structure, and call a Special Parish Assembly to present its findings. The motion carried.

Closing Remarks: Der Paree thanked the membership for their input; and the Assembly Chairman, Secretary, Nominating and Auditing Committees for their contributions. He also congratulated and welcomed the newly elected individuals. However, as we move forward into the 21st century, we must extend helping hands to our newcomers to assist them as they adjust to their new way of life, and instill in our young people the desire to actively contribute to the Parish as plans are made for the future of their church.

The meeting was closed with prayer, and adjourned at 4:40 p.m.

Եկեղեցւոյս բոլոր կազմակերպութիւնները իւրայատուկ օգտակար ծառայութիւններ մատուցանեցին, զանազան ձեռնարկներով։ Բոլոր գործադիր յանձնախումբներուն եւ անոնց անդամներուն մեր գնահատանքը։

Կիրակնօրեայ Դպրոցը իր անձնուէր ուսուցչական կազմով կը չարունակէ իր առաքելուխիւնը։ 100է աւելի աչակերտներ արձանագրուած են։ Անոնք՝ տարւոյն ընթացքին զանազան ընկերային ձեռնարկներ կազմակերպեցին։

Հայաստանի Օգնութեան Ցանձնախումբը ժրաջան գործունկութիւն մը ցուցաբերեց։ Անոնք ձաչկերոյթի ձեռնարկներով կրցան օգտակար ըլլալ եւ նիւթապկս նպաստել Հայաստանի։ Անոնք իրենց մասնակցութիւնը բերին 300 տոլար նուիրելով եկեղեցւոյս պայծառութեան. 100 տոլար՝ Հայաստանի Հիմնադրամին. եւ նաեւ 200 տոլար որբի մը Հոդատարութեան։ Անոնց կը մաղթենք նորանոր յաջողութիւններ։

Մեծ Պահքի ընթացքին, ամէն Ուրբաթ, Հսկումի արարողութիւն, ձաչ եւ դասախօսութեանց չարք մը տեղի պիտի ունենայ։ Ճաչի հիւրընկալներն են - Թէքէեան Մչակութային Միութիւնը եւ Հայաստանի Օգնութեան Ցանձնախումբը։ Մեր չնորհակալութիւնը բոլորին։

Մայիս 2էն մինջեւ 4ը, Թեմիս տարեկան Պատգամաւորական ժողովը տեղի ունեցաւ, հիւրը նկալուխեամբ մեր եկեղեցւոյ։ 150է աւելի երեսփոխաններ եւ հիւրեր ներկայ եղան։ Մեր սրտագին չնորհակալուխիւնները յանձնախումբի բոլոր անդամներուն։

Մինչ կը յիչենք մեր գործունէուԹիւններէն ոմանք, աւելի եւս յոյսով կը կանխատեսենք մեր ապագան։ Ձեզի կ′առաջադրենք մի քանի նպատակներ.–

- 1. Ցառաջիկայ մի քանի տարիներուն կարեւոր է վերահաստատել նոր եկեղեցւոյ անդամագրութեան դաղափարը։ Սուրբ աւագանի մկրտութեամբ, ամէն անձ կը նկատուի եկեղեցւոյ անդամ եւ յանձն կ՛առնէ որոչ պատասխանութիւններ։ Հովուական թերթիկներով աւելի եւս բացատրել այս իրողութիւնը։

- 3. Գալ տարի մեր համայնքը պիտի բոլորէ իր 35րդ տարեդարձը ներկայ վայրի վրայ։ Պիտի փափաքինք նչել այդ տարեդարձը յատուկ տօնակատարուԹեամբ։

Նաեւ 3 տարիէն մարդկութիւնը պիտի թեւակոխէ 3րդ հազարամեակ մը։ Ինչպէս

կարելի է դիմադրաւել եւ կանխատեսել դժուարութիւնները եւ անոնց լուծումը։

Եկեղեցին, որպէսզի յառաջդիմէ իբրեւ նուիրական Հաստատութիւն, դործօն անձերու պէտք ունի։ Ամէն անդամ պարտականութիւն պէտք է զդայ իր տաղանդը եւ ժամանակը տալու։ Պէտք է զօրացնել եկեղեցւոյս անդամադրութիւնը։ Գիտնանք ծառայել Աստուծոյ՝ իր եկեղեցիով։

• The Mer Doon, our official church publication, has been published regularly. It has served a useful purpose in informing our members of current events in our parish life. A very special thank you to Lisa Manookian for editing the Mer Doon and Anie Megerian for typing. She is assisted by Araxie Richards and Noubar Karagulian in addressing and mailing.

The 1997 year presents us another opportunity to serve God in His church. Let us consider a few:

- I propose that we adopt a "Mission Statement" as it appears inside the front cover of the assembly booklet. Let it remind us of the commitment to God and His church from cradle to grave.
- Our community has multi-faceted needs that demand attention: Sunday School, the youth (teens, college youth and adults), married couples, etc. In every area, we need people to carry on the challenge.
- We plan to re-introduce Bible Study fellowship and host marriage enrichment workshops for engaged and married couples. Also a very special opportunity for teens and their parents a series of dialogues with David Terjanian, to address self-esteem themes from the Christian perspective.
- Next year our parish will commemorate the 35th Anniversary of consecration in Wynnewood. Your suggestions would be appreciated.
- The Christian world is preparing to celebrate the 2,000th anniversary of Christ's birth and the Armenian Church's 1,7000th Anniversary and adoption of Christianity as a state religion in the year 301. I propose we form a parish level committee to observe these millenniums and recommend projects for implementation by the next Parish Assembly.
- In conclusion, I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt appreciation to Papken Megerian, chairman Parish Council, for his leadership, cooperation and advice. Also, I wish to thank members of the Parish Council, Diocesan Delegates, executive committees of each organization and supportive members. In fact, without you, there would be no church.

It is my hope that together we can serve the Lord in new and creative ways. There is no doubt that 1997 will be another successful year, with everyone being a part of our success.

REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

This past year, with the help of our Lord, our parish completed another successful year both spiritually and financially. The Parish Council met every other Tuesday to carry on the duties and responsibilities entrusted to them by the Parish Assembly. The Pastor and Parish Council put their best effort forward to reach the needs and satisfy the concerns of the parishioners. At the same time they diligently carried out the mission of the church. The Parish Council also perpetuated the Armenian culture and heritage and extended a helping hand to our Motherland.

The following is a brief overview of the activities that transpired over the past year:

An Open Forum was held January 25, at which various topics of concern were addressed and recommendations were suggested to the Parish Council.

On March 27th, we had an <u>Annual organizational meeting</u>, at which we mutually agreed as to our individual responsibilities and discussed the concerns of the parish.

Palm Sunday ACYOA Day Banquet: On Sunday, March 23, our Juniors with the help of the Youth Committee, sponsored their annual Palm Sunday Banquet honoring Zabelle Zarmanian, a dedicated member of our community.

We had our 3rd annual <u>Plant Sale</u> on May 19. We graciously thank Carol Leszczynski for a job well done.

Our parish hosted the 94th Diocesan Assembly which was a great success both socially and financially. Upon the recommendation of the Assembly Committee the Parish Council approved the usage of the proceeds to upgrade the computer and modernize the office equipment. A special thanks is extended to the Diocesan Assembly Committee under Co-chairperson's George Devletian and Lisa Manookian. We also want to thank the Tekeyan Cultural Association for donating and preparing the Thursday night dinner and to Steve Finley for donating the Sunday brunch during this Assembly.

September Picnic: Our traditional Picnic was a great success. Once again the Picnic was Co-chaired by Sarkis Berberian and Arlet Zeibari.

On Saturday, November 2, Hrashapar Service and reception took place on the occasion of <u>His Beatitude Patriarch Torkom Manookian's</u> visit to Philadelphia. On this happy occasion the Parish Council and the congregation donated a total of \$5,000.00 to help support the Tarkmanchatz School in Jerusalem.

<u>Christmas Bazaar</u>: November 15 & 16, the bazaar was a tremendous success socially, culturally and financially. A special thanks go to co-chairperson's Zevart Shakarjian and Edward Kazanjian and their dedicated committee.

During the past year a Membership committee was formed by the Parish Council, under co-chairperson's Alicia Dakerian Craig and Suren Pakhtigian. Their report and recommendations were reviewed by the Parish Council and will be presented to this Assembly.

We continued the young adult ushering program with success thanks to Araxie Richards who coordinates this program.

This year we also sent a free AIM subscription and Mer Doon issue to our college students.

Besides our Parish activities, this year we have also renegotiated our lease with more favorable terms, with both the Lane School and Finley Catering, from which we will generate additional income. We also express our appreciation to our secretary Anie Megerian who conscientiously performs the office duties.

During the past year the following projects and repairs were completed:

94TH ANNUAL DIOCESAN ASSEMBLY May 2-4, 1996

Commence of the commence of th

The 94th Annual Assembly of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America was hosted by our church on May 2-4, 1996.

The Annual Clergy Conference (April 29-May 1, 1996) took place at the Doylesford Abbey in Paoli with 31 clergymen in attendance. The year 1996 was designated as "The Year of the Youth" by our Primate.

Dr. Garo Garibian was elected chairman of the Assembly; Mr. Arthur Mardigian, Vice-Chairman; Miss Berjoohy Haigazian, English Secretary; The Very Rev. Narez Berberian, Armenian Secretary.

His Eminence, Archbishop Khajag Barsamian, Primate of the Eastern Diocese, presided over the meetings. A message from His Holiness, Lord, Lord, Karekin I, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians was read.

A slate of candidates for Diocesan Board of Trustees, Nominating Committee, Proposals Committee and Auditing Committee were presented and nominations were taken from the floor and the election took place.

In his address to the Assembly, our Primate stated how extremely proud he was of our Diocese in the way the pontifical visit was planned and executed by the national and local committees. He stated that His Holiness, Vehapar Hayrabed, came to this country "to know and be known." The primary task of Vehapar was to get to know his flock in America and for us to know him. Of equal significance was Vehapar's diplomatic mission to this country which involved a great number of meetings with dignitaries from various religious institutions in America as well as high ranking officials of the U.S. government. The visit maintained the dignity and prestige of Holy Etchmiadzin and the Catholicos of all Armenians.

The Primate announced that in accordance with the prerogatives granted by him as Diocesan Primate he would allow clergymen under the jurisdiction of the Catholicate of Cilicia to participate in liturgical functions. On each occasion the local priest should apply to the Primate for permission to hold a joint service. His Eminence stated that he took this initiative in full consciousness and it was an important step toward genuine hierarchical unity.

One afternoon of the Assembly the delegates were divided into four panels-Three Youth Related; One Budget and Finance of the Diocese.

Reports were given by the Unity Committee, Endowment Fund; Mission Parishes and Fund for Armenian Relief.

Messages were given from WGCC, ACYOA, AACCA.

A budget of \$3,613.260.00 was accepted by the delegates after a great deal of discussion.




