

PARISH COUNCIL REPORT TO GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The Parish Council met 15 times during the year of 1968.

Two Executive meetings were held by the Parish Council during the past year. These meetings were held with the officers of the Ladies Aid, the A.C.Y.O.A., and the Sunday School.
