Except for a few Sundays, a sermon or educational lesson was given. I continued the deacon lessons with 3 boys and also with three boys on the reading of Daniel. Holy Communion was received regularly during the course of the year by Sunday School Children. A Youth Program in which children of the Sunday School participated in various duties before, during and after the services was held and also an explanation Badarak Service in which each phase of the Badarak was explained during the service itself. I performed a Sunday morning service at St. Mary's Hospital for the staff and patients in their chapel. Arrangements with Bp. Papken Varjabedian wes made where we had an exchange one Sunday. Arrangements are underway for a similar exchange with the two Philadelphia churches. Sacraments

Meetings

I presided over meetings of all the church organizations and as many officers meetings and committee meetings as feasibly possible. Publicity

The 'Sevan Newsletter' was printed periodically with special issues for Easter and Christmas in addition to the Christmas Greeting Issue. Special announcements were sent during the course of the year. Arrangements were made for guest speakers for all our programs; Dr. Hanessian, Vartanantz; Mr. Aram Pahossian, Martyr's Day; Dr. Sarkissian, Cultural Day; and Dr. Surpouhi Essefian on The Name-Day Celebration. Letters were sent inviting knowledgeable persons in the subjects of the lectures and arrangements were made with the news medias publicizing these events and other ceremonies such as the Washing-of-the-feet Ceremony article printed during Holy Week. I sent letters to these people acknowledging our communities *M& gratitude. There was correspondence pertaining to church and church related business and affairs which also includes writing letters for certain of our parishoners upon special requests, and for our organizations.

Sunday School

I devised a Sunday School Program for all of the Sunday School Classes with the hope of bringing uniformity to the teaching system from year to year. Also the correspondence required for/information and materials Iused in this program.
