#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The parish council was subdivided this year into committees in an attempt to address our major responsibilities. The building and grounds committee oversaw the routine care of the church and investigated improvements.

The membership committee began a long term process of investigating the needs not being met for present and potential members and sought an approach to attracting new membership. The choir committee met difficulty in its goal to find a choir director and active choir members willing to give time for practice and for Sunday services. The recent loss of the services of our deacon emphasized the need for more participation. On the positive side Mary Okhanes agreed to study in order to help as organist. Twenty new robes were purchased through the generosity of parishionners. The Youth and Cultural committee was established to provide a Direct link to the parish council from the youth (Sunday School, Armenian School, ACYOA, etc.) and from the Cultural Committee of the church. Young adults were encouraged to help pass the collection plate and greet members as they arrived on A Cultural Day Dinner and Program was sponsored. The Softball Team was sponsored again this year and proved formidable in their league.

#### CLERGY:

Through the Diocesean Committee Stipend Committee the parish council was made aware of previous miscalculations in the clergy salary. This year's budget reflects the amount stipulated by the stipend committee and represents about six thousand dollars a year more than previously allowed. The 1983 salary is \$22,600 which includes auto allowance but does not include the parish house, utilities, insurance, and retirement.
