THE 1985 1985 PARISH ASSEMBLY

NOTE: Article 6 of the Diocesan By-laws:

"Every member of the Parish, 18 years of age or over, shall pay to his or her church an annual due, the amount of which shall be determined by the Diocesan Assembly. Such amount may be increased, but not decreased by the Parish Assembly. Dues are payable in advance on January first of each year."

Article 7 of the Diocesan By-laws:

"Members in good standing of a Parish Church, who are 18 years of age or over, may participate in the assemblies of the same Parish and may vote, provided that at least six months have elapsed since the date of their registration as members of the Parish and their dues have been paid. They may be eligible for office one year after becoming members provided they have attained the age of 21."
