Visitations are important part of my duties. I have visited parishioners at hospitals and at their homes whenever needed. Home blessings were also done upon request on Christmas and Easter.

The unsuccessful organization which I tried to establish was the gathering of young Adults. Until now we do not have an organized Young Adults Group. I feel that it is important that the young adults realize that our Church needs their support and help. We must train new young parishioners to work in the Parish Council, in the women's Guild and in the other Church organizations. They are our future leaders, and if we loose and discourage them our community life will be endangered.

It must be our goal to work together. We must help our Church morally and especially financially otherwise the Church would not be able to grow and accomplish her activities. We need to increase our membership. It is not only the task of the Pastor or the Parish Council to bring new members but it is our obligation as a community to work hard for increasing our membership. I assure you, if we work together we will have more than 150 members in our community. The Pastor can not do everything by himself but people can as a group.

I pray God that the year 1995 be a successful year for our community and we grow as a true Christians having the love of Christ and the peace of His Divine Grace upon us, so we may be able to hear what He is telling us to say and to do. May God bless our community.
