Minutes of Meeting with Clergy Committee for the 1700th Anniversary of the Conversion of Armenia to Christianity May 16, 2000

- 1. The meeting was opened with a prayer led by the Primate at 1:45 p.m. Present were Rev. Frs. Papken Anoushian, Diran Bohajian, Daniel Findikyan, Vazken Karayan, Karekin Kasparian, Untzag Nalbandian and Simeon Odabashian. Rev. Frs. Vertanes Kalayjian and Garabed Kochakian were absent.
- 2. The Primate introduced the purpose of this committee for the benefit of those attending for the first time. The purpose is to ascertain the clergies' input concerning the preparation of a guidebook for parish activities in commemoration of the 1700th anniversary. The clergies' opinions and evaluations on proposed plans are essential as to which programs are likely to be successfully implemented on the parish level. The following plans are in the works: Catholicos' visit to New York to be organized by young professional group, symposia by ZIC, booklets on church teaching by SNS, choir from Armenia, pilgrimage to historic Armenia In the Steps of St. Gregory. A video of the pilgrimage will be prepared and disseminated to the parishes.
- 3. Other ideas:

Contest for the youth to compose appropriate song and poetry.

SNS to accept 17 new students.

Ecumenical service booklet.

Prayerbook with 17 prayers.

- 4. Intent: Recommit ourselves to the faith of St. Gregory.
- 5. Specific Programs

A. 4 Parish wide commemorations tied to feasts related to St. Gregory

- I. Sons and Grandsons of St. Gregory in February
- II. Entrance into the Pit in March

Perhaps the meal can be simple with just bread and salt in remembrance of St. Gregory's imprisonment.

- III. Hripsime, Gayane, Deliverance from the Pit, Etchmiadzin, Shoghagat, Trdat & Ashkhen in **June**
 - June will be declared the "Month of Pilgrimage In the Steps of St. Gregory"
- IV. Holy Translators in October

Pilgrimage video would be viewed at the October commemoration.

After some discussion it was decided that the above should take place on appointed Saturday evenings.

Public relations is essential to successful implementation

Half hour service based on our tradition with readings and appropriate hymns (and translations) available for the congregation.

Involve as many as possible in the service especially the youth.

Children can be involved in passing out and lighting parishioners' candles.

The booklet will include the text of the service in Armenian, English and perhaps Russian; story of the feast and its meaning for us today.

The service will be followed by a meal. Church organizations can be asked to organize each event.

Suggestion that the 2001 diocesan calendar indicate all of the special commemorations. Guidebook will give suggestions on how to celebrate each feast, with resources including pertinent works from Armenian literature, speakers, plays, recitations.

B. Opening of 1700th Anniversary

This will take place with a short prayer service following Divine Liturgy on Sunday, January 14, 2001. There will be no Hokehankist that day. An appropriate icon of St. Gregory will be massed produced for the parish to be displayed in a prominent place. On the opening day this will be blessed perhaps anointed with Muron and a lantern – Loosavorchi Gantegh with be lit in front of it. It was suggested that people take the flame home with them. Prayer cards with the above icon and with a prayer of rededication will be distributed. All will recite the prayer together.

An explanation of the legend of *Loosavorchi Gantegh* will be made available to the public.

The concepts of the baptismal vows – Faith, Hope and Love should be incorporated in the prayer.

C. Service for the closing of the 1700th anniversary will take place on a Sunday in December, 2001

D. Ecumenical Service

Primate suggested that our clergy approach local ecumenical organizations to see the possibility of having the 1700th anniversary commemorative ecumenical service hosted by a non-Armenian congregation. Ideally the local ecumenical body will be the organizer.

- 6. The Sourcebook will have two categories:
 - 1. mandatory programs
 - 2. optional recommended activities

Bible study guide geared to the theme of recommitment to span the year 2001. Sermon outlines following a similar theme.

7. Miscellaneous Ideas

Parishes should set up special booths at bazaars and festivals to distribute information to the community at large concerning the 1700th anniversary.

Vocation Sunday will emphasize the importance of the priesthood. Clergy can give testimonies concerning their calling on that occasion. The goal will be to encourage men to consider the priesthood.

1700th anniversary souvenirs should be mass produced – such as pens, pins, crosses, icon magnets, key chains

A schedule of the yearlong activities will be printed in bulletins and newsletters.

8. Clergy were asked to review proposed plans of the departments and think of other ideas for the commemoration to be discussed at the next meeting – Wednesday, May 31 11-12:30. The meeting ended with a prayer at 4:00 p.m.

1700 Anniversary Committee Meeting Wednesday, April 12, 2000, 3:00 pm

Attendance: Archbishop Khajag Barsamian, Fr. Krikor Maksoudian, Mr. Michael Haratunian, Mr. Aram Arkun, Mr. George Kassis and Ms. Karen Bedrosian Richardson.

The meeting convened at 3:20 PM with Archbishop Khajag Barsamian offering the opening prayer. The minutes of the meeting of March 16, 2000 were approved as revised. Michael Haratunian stated that this committee has been meeting for one year discussing programs and activities for the 1700th Anniversary celebration. After one year of thinking it is time to go to work and implement the ideas that have been discussed.

- 1. **Exhibit:** Mr. Haratunian reported that, as previously decided, we would not proceed with the original exhibit program with the University of Michigan. We will, however, explore the possibility of a mini-exhibit in conjunction with the concert. Karen Bedrosian Richardson has agreed to chair the sub-committee for this exhibit. She will work with the Primate in examining the items that the Diocese has in its archives and their condition. They will also look into questions of packaging, transport and insurance, etc. if the exhibit were to travel with the concert to different parishes.
- 2. **Concert:** Mr. Haratunian reported that Sahan Arzruni would travel to Armenia this summer to audition choral groups and decide which group will perform at the concert. Mr. Arzruni will be asked to form a concert sub-committee. The New York concert is tentatively scheduled for the last week of October 2001. If the local parishes are agreeable, the concert could be performed in Boston, Detroit, Washington, DC, Philadelphia, Chicago, Boca Raton and Providence. The budget for the New York concert appears as **attachment 1**.
- 3. **Teaching Role of the Church:** The six pamphlets will be ready at the end of the year. George Kassis was asked to prepare a budget. 60,000 of each pamphlet will be printed, of which 38,000 will be mailed to the Diocesan mailing list and the rest sent to the parishes for local distribution.
- 4. **Ecumenical Service:** The Primate will be meeting with the National Council of Churches on May 15th and will have further information to provide to the committee at its next meeting.
- 5. **Youth:** Michael Haratunian stated that youth activities must be planned at the parish and regional levels. Fr. Untzag will be asked to speak to Fr. Vasken to prepare a proposal for these activities.
- 6. **Major Religious Event:** A sub-committee is being formed to plan this event.

- 7. Academic: Fr. Krikor presented a revised schedule, which appears as <u>attachment</u> 2, for a conference and symposium to take place during the second week of September 2001. The conference panels will discuss contemporary issues while the symposium will deal with more academic topics. Simon Balian, Arda Haratunian and Karen Bedrosian Richardson will be asked to serve on the subcommittee for the conference.
- 8. **Public Relations:** George Kassis presented the logo and letterhead submitted by Armen Garabedian. Suggestions and changes will be forwarded to Mr. Garabedian and he will be asked to incorporate them and submit new samples. Suggested as text for the banner were: "1700 Years in Affirmation of Christianity" and "The Enlightenment of the Armenian Nation."
- 9. **Fundraising:** An informal meeting was held on March 19, 2000 of the tentative fundraising subcommittee. The draft of the minutes of that meeting appears as **attachment 3.**
- 10. **Parish Activities:** The Primate reported that he will be meeting with a group of clergy this coming week and he will discuss with them parish activities for the 1700th Anniversary.
- 11. **Pilgrimage:** George Kassis reported that the pilgrimage to historic Armenia would be a 10-day trip. The pilgrims will travel to Caeserea. From there, the pilgrims will be divided into groups to visit their ancestral lands (Adana, Aintab, Sivas and Diyarbekir). The pilgrims will then reunite in Kars and travel to Ani from where they will cross into Armenia. An extension of stay in Armenia could also be offered.
- 12. **Next Meeting:** The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 1, 2000 at 2:00 PM in the Tahlij at the Diocese of the Armenian Church.

The meeting adjourned at 5:00 PM with the Primate offering the closing prayer.

Armenian Spiritual Leadership Fund Prepare leadership that talks to your children as to you (Notes from the informal meeting held Sunday, March 19, 2000)

Objective:

<u>To Make the Armenian Church significant in the life of every Armenian and his/her family.</u>

Background:

The Armenian Church has, for 1700 years, been the bedrock upon which we have maintained our heritage and spiritual values. The Church is the one institution where all Armenians come together to connect with their identities as Armenian Christians. It is the center and focus of our communities throughout all of America and around the world. The challenge is to prepare the leadership of tomorrow and to make the Armenian Church in America relevant and meaningful to the coming generations. 1700 years ago St. Gregory the Illuminator took the extraordinary step of bringing Christianity to Armenia and establishing the first Christian nation in the whole world. Today as we celebrate this great occasion, we invite you to take an extraordinary step towards our future as Armenian Christians.

Today, over 600,000 Armenians live in the geographical region of the Eastern Diocese. To minister adequately we need to take extraordinary steps to move forward with the spiritual preparation and continuous education of pastoral and lay leaders of the Church to meet the spiritual needs of our children as well as our spiritual needs. Estimating one pastor for every 5,000 Armenians, the Church needs 120 clergy, as contrasted with fewer than 50 at present. While lay leaders are normally involved on a part-time, and usually volunteer basis, lay leadership needs are even greater, and at the moment hardly attended to. If we estimate one lay leader for every 1,000 Armenians, some 600 persons need to be trained.

The Armenian Spiritual Leadership Fund is aimed at ensuring adequate funding to attract, develop and nurture this pastoral and lay leadership in the service of the Church, and thus will benefit every Armenian and every Armenian Church, both directly and indirectly.

Specific Purposes:

- Training of future pastors
- Continuous education of serving pastors
- Pastor sabbaticals
- Orienting and training of Parish Council members
- Orienting and training of Diocesan Delegates
- Training of Diocese and Parish staff responsible for church-wide programs
- Preparing the next generation of youth leaders, parish council members, Diocesan delegates and church-wide program leaders at the Diocesan level.

Important Initial First Steps:

- 1. Agree on a symbol
- 2. Form the Larger Committee and agree on its Executive Team.
- 3. Build a consensus among the clergy to support and promote the initiative
- 4. Plan the coming out event
- 5. Investigate how to contact Sam Simonian and his partner Akulian as possible major donors.

It was agreed to convene the next meeting on Saturday, April 29 at 9 a.m.
