PARISH COUNCIL -- 1978 -- CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

As my two year term as a Parish Council Member and Chairman comes to an end, I look back at the experiences which produced hardships, disappointments, some productivity, anxieties and hopes of things to come.

A slight slag occured due to the shock of Hayr Soorp Arshag's leaving, creating a disappointment and hardship for us all. Yet this did not deter the activities of our church's Women's Guild. They were the only group to show a continuity of productivity.

Your Parish Council tried to provide as many services on Sunday mornings as it possibly could by having Hayr Shnork of St.

John's Greenfield Church come when he was available. Yet every Sunday morning services were held to keep the church doors open. This was somewhat disappointing as only a handful of faithfuls attended these services. To those few I extend my heartfelt thanks.

Your Parish Council did finally get the roof repairs completed. There are still some repairs to be done such as fixing the soffit boards of the eaves. The boards are rotted and this task I leave to the incoming newly elected Parish Council.

My congratulations to this years picnic committee for the successful picnic they managed. Our church realized a fair profit of approximately fifty percent over last years profit.

Since Hayr Soorp Arshag left us your Parish Council has been in constant touch with the Diocesan headquarters and His Grace Archbishop Torkom Manoogian for a replacement. At the last Diocesan Assembly which was held in Detroit, His Grace informed your Parish Council Chairman that he had a student for us but he was three years away from being ordained, and asked if we coulc wait. Your Chairman said that the parishioners could not wait and that a priest was needed very badly for our parish if it was to remain in existance. He was very sympathetic and apologetic but there just isn'tanyone available at this time.

The creation of a new budget always causes a financial burden on every family and person associated with our church. We must work toward removing any roadblocks that make it increasingly difficult for your Parish Council to operate profitably and with

the costs of everything escalating as they are, we are going to have a more difficult time to balance the budget. You can all help in this aspect by paying your church dues on time rather than letting them linger. We realize that only through efficient and constant control of our costs, we we then be able to effectively maintain the operation of the church for you.

A special thanks to a very young man, Master Marty Granec, who took care of the church grounds for us this past summer.


My congratulations to the newly elected Parish Council and I wish them great success in their endeavors for the coming year.

ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY

SUNDAY, JANUARY 28, 1979

The meeting was called to order by Parish Council Chairman, Harold Baylerian at 2:30 p.m. There were twenty eight members present.

Parish Council Chairman, Harold Baylerian gave the annual report of the Parish Council. He said there were ten regular Badaraks held during the year with short morning services held on all other Sundays. There were six funerals and three weddings. He said the Auditing Committee reported that all books were audited and found to be in good order.

Financial reports were given by the Parish Council, Women's Guild and Cemetary Committee. Copies were distributed among the attending members.

There were no reports from the Jr. ACYOA and Choir.

A question was brought up about overpaying on the 1978 Diocesan dues. Considering the fact that less dues are paid when there is no priest. Harold stated the dues paid were for 1977 when our parish had a priest.

Harold commedned the Ladies Aid for their job well done during the past year, and also thanked Margaret Kademian for the typing and printing of the Church Bulletins.

1978 REPORT

In addition to holding weekly classes, the Sunday School has undertaken a very special responsibility in the parish this past year. With the approval of Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, the Sunday School volunteered to conduct a short Church Service each Sunday. The children implemented the 45 minute service with the help of some members of the Church Choir, Deacon Harold Baylerian and Acolytes.

The service begins at 10:00 A.M. and consists of a short morning service conducted by the Choir followed by the recital of the Creed, the reading of the Gospel, and the singing of various songs from the Badarak conducted by the Sunday School. The service begins and ends with the Lord's Prayer.

Sunday School classes are held following the service. Texts and other instructional materials are provided through the Diocese.

Although the children's service cannot substitute for weekly Badarak with a priest, the service at least fills some of the void in the absence of a parish priest.

As always, anyone who is interested in helping with Sunday School is most welcome. Parents may enroll their children at any time.
