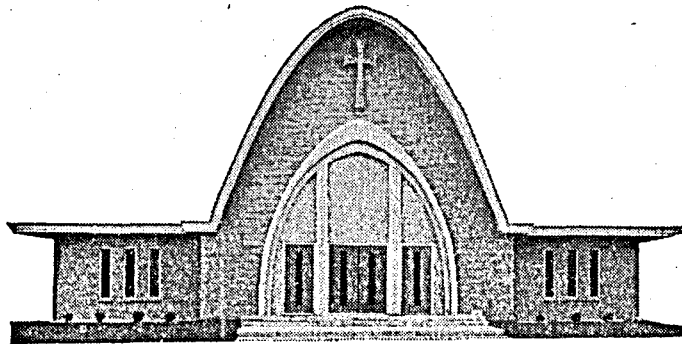




KEGHART ANNUAL REPORT -1988

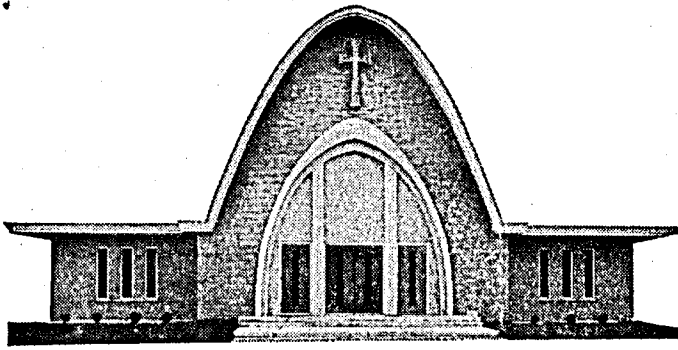
