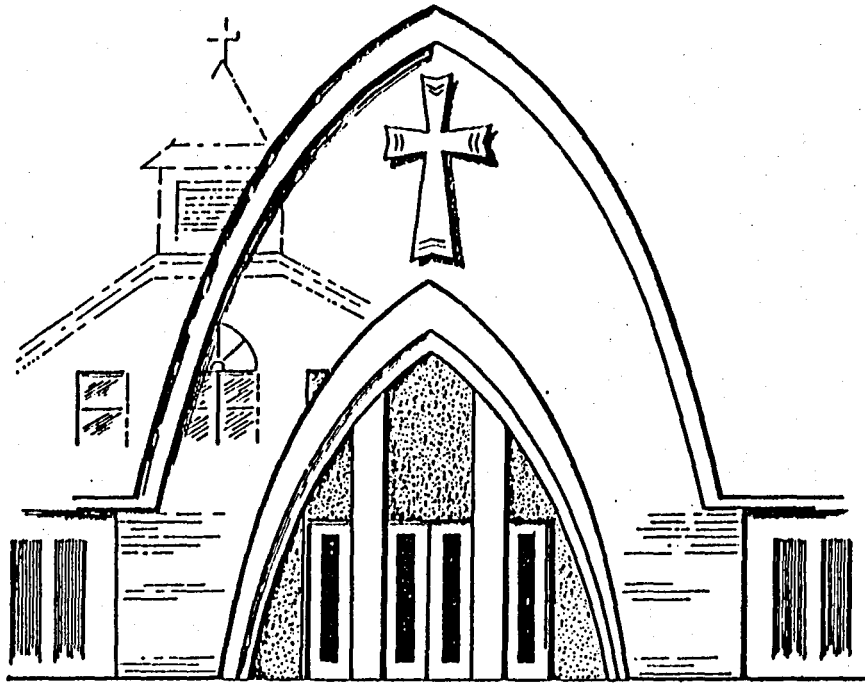

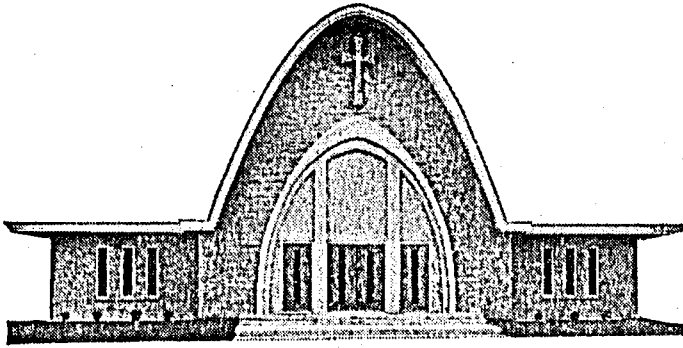

Our Annual Parish Assembly will take place in the Church Hall Sunday, February 11, 1990. All members are urged to attend.

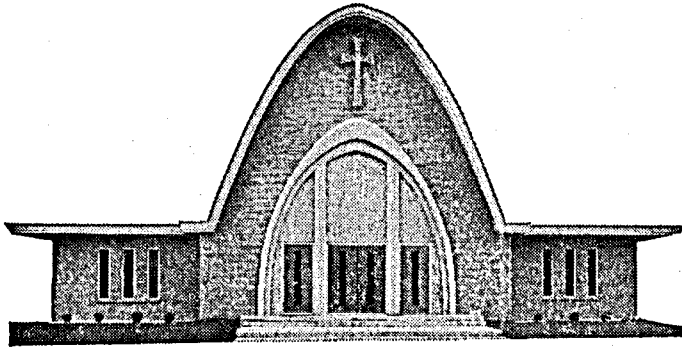

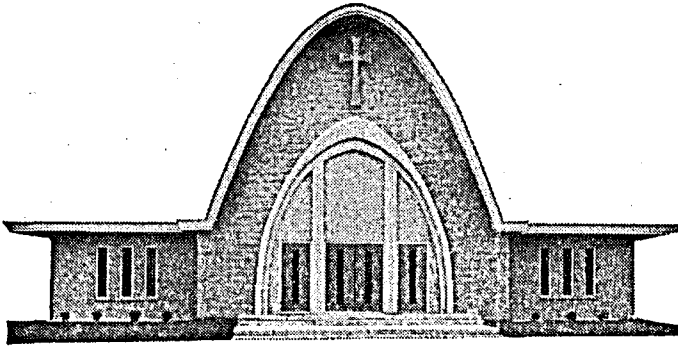

I have talked to some of the members about getting together and making plans for various activities with our sister churches. We have already had an unofficial ACYOA outing, which was very successful. A lot of enthusiasm has been shown for future activities.

WOMEN'S GUILD

My special thanks to all of the members of our Women's Guild. It is because of your help that we have had a neat and clean church, hall, kitchen and office. We all are very happy that we have an organized Women's Guild. I know there are many of you out there that are willing to work and do anything for this Church. But, don't you think it would be easier if we were more organized, thereby making it more pleasant to work together? Soon, we will have more activities coming up for our community.

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL GROUP

Some of you are not familiar with this group. We meet once a month in different Armenian Churches under Father Garabed's guidance.
