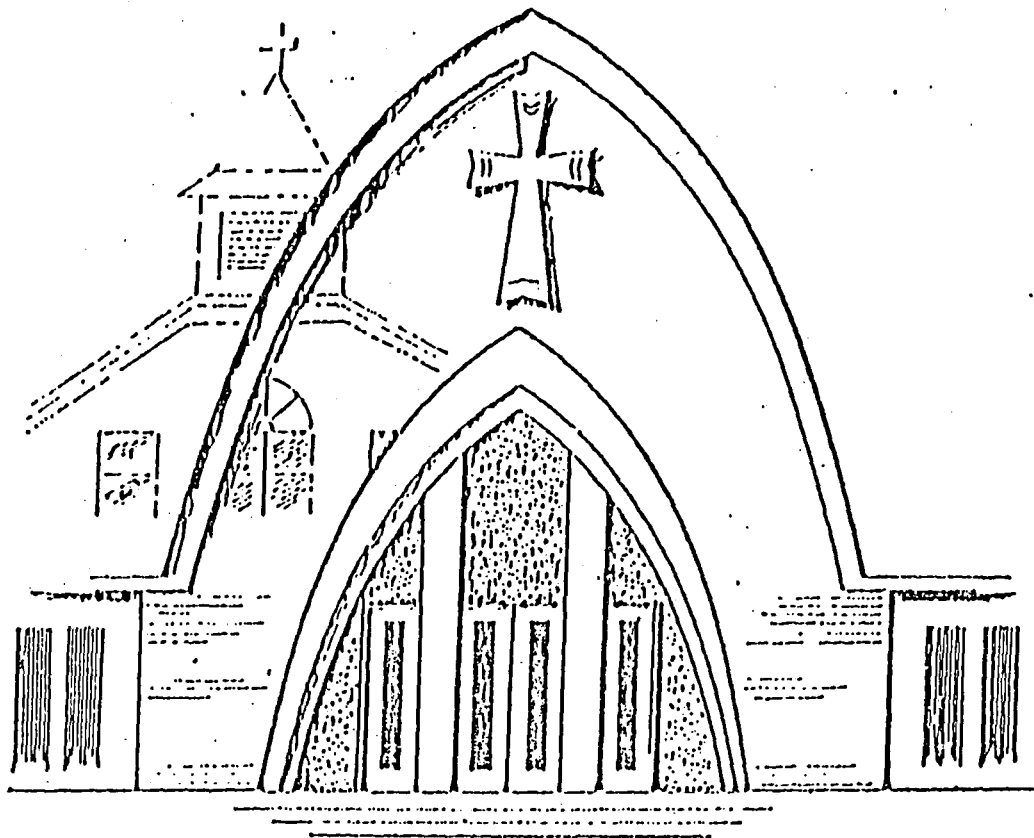

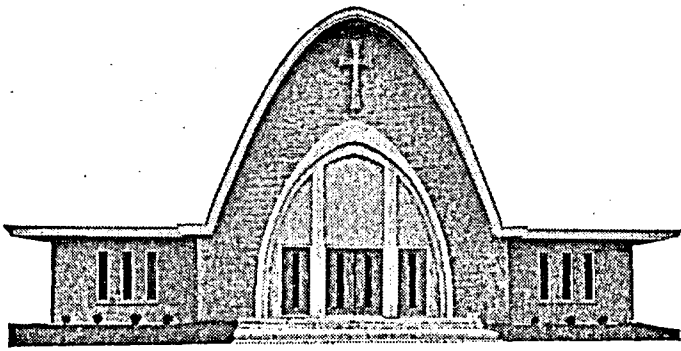

Report

- February 27 - Pot Luck Dinner: Proceeds from the Pot Luck dinner was donated to OPERATION WINTER RESCUE in the amount of \$113.00. Women's Guild sponsored the dinner.
- February 9 - W.G. baked approximately 350 zyloogs to have on hand for Sunday fellowship and also available for sale. We plan on baking khabali sometime in the New Year.
- February 21 - Annual Parish Council Membership Meeting; Due to bad weather conditions the meeting was cancelled, however lunch was still served.
- February 24 - Mas was prepared for Sunday Church services. We plan on baking Mas again in January.
- March 7 - Annual Parish Council Membership Meeting; Lunch was prepared and before the meeting following services.
- March 20 - Women's All Saint's Day: St. John's Armenian Church Women's Guild of Greenfield sponsored All Saint's Day. Our parish was very well represented for the service and lunch. We mailed circulars to our members assisting our sister Church.
- Easter Donations of \$207.00 was collected from our members for the Lily plants and flowers for the Kerezman.
- August 22 - Grape Blessing: Grapes this year were donated by Der Hayr and donations were made by our members. Approximately 75 bags of the blessed grapes were distributed to our parishioners.
- October 1 - Church hall floors and stairway was cleaned and waxed by Albert Stelzer and the charge was only \$60.00.
- October 15 - Church pantry and kitchen was cleaned and put in order.
- December 15 - Madagh dinner was prepared and served for the funeral of Takouie Green, and approximately 100 people were present for the meal. We thank Kay Kademian and Sema Hayalian for preparing the madagh and pilaf.
- December - Donations of \$276.00 was collected from our parishioners for the poinsetta plants.
