

ACTIVITIES

- March 12, 1994 The Guild hosted the Women's Saints Day for the four Midwest area Churches, followed with a luncheon and program. Guest were Fr. Yeprem Kelegian from St. Mesrob Church of Racine; Fr. Davit Boyajian and Deacon Minas Keutelian from St. John's Church of Greenfield; Sonia Harlan, Midwest Regional Program Coordinator and Fr. Vahram Hazarian. Special guest speaker was Arpine Khatchadourian and also Sonia Harlan. Total attendance was 91.
- April 2, 1994 The Guild prepared refreshments for the Egg Rolling Party, sponsored by the Parish Council.
- April 24, 1994 The Guild prepared a Madagh Dinner on the anniversary of the Martyr's Day Memorial (Armenian Massacre) sponsored by the Parish Council. Total attendance was 88.
- September 10, 1994 A special meeting of the Midwest Guilds was held at St. George Armenian Church in Waukegan with a luncheon (pot luck). Getting acquainted and exchanges of ideas, along with other Churches that was there, proved to be a very interesting meeting. Sonia Harlan, Midwest Regional Program Coordinator presided over the meeting.
- October 19, 1994 Armenian Fest Dinner was held in the Church hall. It was an authentic Armenian cuisine and had a complete sell out, plus bakeries on the side, needless to say that it was open to the public.

1994 was a very busy year with everyone working together. We have 18 paid members and of these 10 are active. During the course of the year, get-well cards were sent out by Mary Haidarian and special visits to a few; flowers were ordered either/or for Easter and Christmas by Mary Boyajian; and the Sacristy and Altar Candles was cared by Namzar Kaprelian. Needless to add the cleaning the Church proper and hall by the members.

A check for 60% of our annual net income was transferred to the Parish Council.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

During the last year the children in our Sunday School have been learning about the Bible, Jesus and Gods love, healing power and his forgiveness. They made Advent Wreaths and prepared for Christmas by lighting candles at home with their families. The children proudly re-enacted the birth of Christ and presented the story for everyone on January 8, 1995. The Lord's Prayer, sign of the cross and Kiss of Peace are practiced by the children in class and at home. The children will be introduced to Holy Spirit, the Sacraments, the Saints, the Badarak, and the life and resurrection of Christ before they break for the summer.

The children learn these things through a variety of activities. We hear stones, role play, sing songs, do many arts and crafts projects, share snacks and pray together.

The following materials have been purchased, donated or created to facilitate a hands on learning environment in our Sunday School: Arts and craft supplies, snacks, puppets, puzzles, games, costumes, audio and visual tapes and Sunday School text books.

We have five children who attend Sunday School regularly and a few others who join us occasionally. We have one teacher and two student aides, namely, Nadine Zakian and Tamara Hazarian, and receive additional support from parents and other members. We hope to increase our regular enrollment again next year.
