- 1. During year of 1963, 4 parish assemblies held.
- 2. Joined Racine Council of Churches.
- 3. As instructed by 1963 Annual Parish Assembly, purchased 40 acres of land on Highway 31 about four miles north of City of Racine in Racine County.

EXCERPTS FROM PASTOR'S REPORT

- 1. In addition to sacraments reported in Annual Report, Pastor performed one baptism in St. Paul's Armenian Church in Syracuse, New York.
- 2. 55 Holy Badaraks performed in 1963, as well as 14 other liturgical services. Parish Priest gave 67 sermons in the past year.
- 3. Two people received into the Armenian Church. Both were Roman Catholics, who had been baptised and confirmed.
- 4. Parish Priest made 328 visitations, had 24 counselling sessions, attended 120 organizational meetings and gatherings, and gave 31 talks during the past year.
- 5. An adult study group met 35 times during the year under the leadership of Pastor, who also taught an Armenian School class and an acolytes class.

6. Pastor also attended 15 extra-parochial gatherings.
