Parish Council Report

As chairman of the 1979 Parish Council, let me state that we accomplished many of the goals expected of us. First, I consider our prime task was to keep the doors of the church open, to keep our organizations active and working, to run your church efficiently and in a businesslike manner, to maintain harmonious relations with the Diocese and sister churches and to nourish your spiritual needs.

I believe your council worked well as a group and was cooperative in undertaking the many tasks before it. They met faithfully on almost a regular weekly basis. My personal thanks and appreciation go to council members, Sahag Akgulian, Robert Akulian, Adam Barootian, Gene Chardukian, Mike Garoukian and to Mesag Vidian. I'd also like to express thanks on behalf of the parish to our three outgoing members, Robert Akulian, Gene Chardukian and Adam Barootian. They all gave many hours of their time in your behalf for the good and the welfare of your church.

At this time when there is no permanent clergy in the parish, your council is left with the duty of keeping the parish active. We tried with your cooperation. I feel our parish activities have not suffered much during the past year. We owe a great deal, of course, to all of you who gave of your time and talents to keep us moving ahead. We are also indebted to our deacons, choir, altar servers, guild, sunday school and Armenian school teachers and staff, project and picnic committee members and to our ACYOA, Jr. advisors. To anyone else whom I may have missed, but gave dedicated effort, our special thanks. I would also like to pay special recognition to an individual who always seems to be there when we need him. I mean Hayr Varoujan, who has been an important part of our apiritual life for the past 20 years. For his untiring efforts in our behalf, we thank him and his parish for sharing him with us without complaint.

Now having all of the thanks out of the way, I'm sure all of you are interested in knowing what has been done to get us a permanent clergyman. For the past year, we have communicated with five priests within our Diocese. One was not interested in coming to the mid-west for reasons of health. A second while interested and willing to come to Racine was simply not affordable by us. A third was content in his present parish and unwilling to make a move at this time. The fourth has not communicated with us since showing interest initially. The fifth, with whom we are in contact has shown interest and wants to visit Racine to discuss the matter further. We are presently attempting to arrange a date that is mutually acceptable to both parties. For purposes of confidentiality, I am not at liberty to give you the names of any of the individuals contacted. However, we want to assure you that the search is of prime concern to us and every effort will be made to be successful this year. That is all we can tell you at the present time.

In summation, I can tell you your church is healthy, it is active, it is prospering and it is spiritually alive. With your continued support and dedication we can do better and much more in 1980. However, we can do it only with your total efforts. Each of you, regardless of your personal contribution is important to our overall progress. We encourage you to continue to give us your wholehearted support.

ST. MESROB PROJECTS COMMITTEE 1979 ANNUAL REPORT

The Project Committee lost one of its most reliable members during the past year, Mr. Harry Musurlian. Mr. Musurlian joined the committee when it was originally organized and gave not only his time, but also gave us the added spark we sometimes needed when we were down on ourselves. He will be missed by his fellow members.

The Project Committee does not have a financial report because all monies are subsidized by the Parish Council.

The members of the committee would like to thank the ACYO members who provided their assistance in grass cutting during the summer months. A special thanks to Myron Chordegian who provided his services during the daytime hours whenever called upon.

The Committee is still seeking new blood to help with the many projects that are required, especially in the summer months. Many of our members are in the retired age group, thus making some of these jobs very heavy chores. The committee normally meets every Thursday night which amounts to two to three hours of an individual's time. This time may be helpful by providing you exercise which your doctor may have already prescribed.

The 1979 year was a very active year for the committee because many large projects were undertaken. The greatest share of time was spent on the parish home. The house was cleared of all trash, cleaned and completely redecorated. Various broken windows on storm doors and windows were replaced. A medicine cabinet donated by Arshag Azarian was installed in the bathroom. Major repairs were also performed on the garage, such as repairing the overhang on the roof, straightening out the rear portion, and repairing the service door.

Listed below are numerous accomplishments and projects throughout the year:

- 1. Stripping and waxing of all the tiled floors in the gym, kitchen and corridors.
- 2. Maintenance work, general landscaping, grass cutting, trimming of trees and shrubs, and miscellaneous duties done on a weekly basis.
- 3. Moving of a garage donated by the Johnson Realty Company from Guido's Restaurant to church property. A special thanks to Jack Krikorian, Harry Cherkinian and Mike Garoukian who contributed their time on this project.

- 4. General maintenance of oil filters, air compressors, oiling of motors, and periodic checks of all valves and gauges for furnace controls.
- 5. Maintenance and general house cleaning of gym storage area done on a periodical basis.
- 6. Subcontracting the repairs of roof in hall and installing new asbestos tiles in corridor.
- 7. Installing new vent motor for exhausting in men's room and restoration of towel rack in women's washroom.
- 8. New shelves installed in kitchen storage room and vent outlet shut-off to outside north wall.
- 9. New bearing installed on pump in boiler room.
- 10. Movie screen hung on east wall in gym.
- 11. Cleaning of sludge in grease trap box in kitchen, casters added to wood chopping block, and repair to fence surrounding garbage can area.
- 12. Wood chips put along both sides of entrance walkway.
- Partial patching of cracks in black top, but this work was not completed due to insufficient manpower.
- 14. A replacement magazine rack donated by Arshag Azarian placed in large conference room.

The Projects Committee held a breakfast on August 26, 1979 and derived a net profit of \$289.60. This money being held in escrow by the Parish Council for purchase of new capital equipment.
