ST. MESROB PROJECTS COMMITTEE 1980 ANNUAL REPORT

The PROJECT COMMITTEE doesn't have a financial report because all monies are subsidized by the Parish Council, or through donations by the committee members. The only money the committee has was derived from a breakfast held last year. The \$289.60 profit was turned over to the Parish Council to be held in escrow until the committee needed the money for new capital equipment.

The members of the committee would like to thank our junior members: namely Nick Akgulian, Bryan Mikaelian, and David Stevoff who assisted in the grass cutting during the summer months. A special thanks to Myron Chordegian and Al Topalian who provided their services for various projects in the day time hours. The committee extends another thanks to Sahag Akgulian who helped in relieving the work load by obtaining a commerical Jacobsen Lawn Mower for experimental purposes, with St. Mesrob Church property being it's home base.

The biggest project this year was in maintaining the rear portion of the property. Grass cutting was done on regular basis to keep wild grass growth under control.

Another major project this year was the painting of all eight class rooms through-out the building. This was done on a weekly basis during the winter months. This entire project should be completed within the next few months.

Listed below are other numberous accomplishments completed through the entire year.

- Pouring of concrete slab for the garage. This work done by David Azarian, Arshag Azarian and George Solakian. Positioning the Garage on to the slab was also completed.
- 2. General landscaping, grass cutting, tree and shrub trimming, and miscellaneous outdoor duties done as a weekly Thursday night project.
- 3. In order to beautify the back section of the property for future years committee member Arshag Azarian donated and planted (23) new trees.
- 4. Stripping and waxing of all the tiled floors in the gym, kitchen, and corridors.
- 5. General maintenance of oil filters, air compressors, oiling of motor, and periodic checks of all valves and guages for furnace control.
- 6. A special seminar was held for the purpose of instructing members on how to flush out the heating system. Special instruction were typed and posted on the bulletin board. Seminar given by Kaelber Heating.

- 7. Installation of a new mail box completed by Arshag Azarian.
- 8. New shelves installed in the printing room by Myron Chordegian and Al Topalian.
- 9. Cleaning of sludge in grease trap in kitchen.
- 10. Due to water damage on ceiling tiles the committee went through each room and replaced with new ones after painting each room.

- 5 It is important to cooperate with the visiting or permanent clergy. Individual workings are not successful and is not beneficial to the parish and we all know we are under Diocesan law and we must repeat it. Respective
- 6 The youth of St. Mesrob must alway find the doors of the Church open to them. - No exceptions. A day or evening must be designated so that they can come and use the hall with their non-Armenian friends. Of course, they must abide by the Parish laws and should have a sponsor present.
- 7 The Parish letter should be continued because it is the mouth of the Church.

- 9 The membership dues should be increased because of inflation.
- 10 The Parish should form a calendar with non-Church organizations such as: The Knights of Vartan, The Daughters of Vartan and the A.G.B.U., so that the affairs will not conflict with each other.
- 11 If one belongs to a non-Church organization, it should not keep them from attending Church. This would be hypocritical.
- 12 You must encourage any affair given by the youth of the Church, be it the Choir, Sunday School or A.C.Y.O.A.
