We also have been pleased that 5 of our young people attended the St. Nersess Summer Conferences in New York.

This year we had the honor of receiving for the second time the Gomidas Vartabed Award, presented to the Church Choir of our diocese that has met all requirements of the Choir Association of our diocese. This was presented at the annual choir assembly that convened this year in Detroit.

(1987 Annual Report)

Fiscal 1987 can be best described as a year of service and maintenance of your properties.

Most of our efforts were implemented during the year 1986 which were to enhance the properties prior to the 1986 National Diocesan Convention. Major capital accomplishments were attended to at that time with the finalization taking plate in 1987. This included the asphalt black top to the parking lot, striping and finishing the hall with acoustical material.

One major item still to be resolved is the changing of the track system for the altar curtain. An investigation has already taken place regarding this matter and from all indications the system should be revised to a I-Beam track unit.

We would like to express our tanks to the Haban Manufacturing Company for the loan of a 16 H.P. tractor. Our equipment required extensive repairs thus the Haban tractor was a welcome sight. The committee still feels that an appropriation of \$5000 be placed into the budget each year in the event of an emergency.

The committee would like to express our thanks to the women of the congregation who again helped the committee with their assistance in shrub trimming and planting of flowers at various areas on the grounds.

As we've stated in previous reports the committee could use all the help it can get, especially during the summer months. We know that there are a lot of retirees out there, and we would appreciate their voluntary support.

Finally a willingness of each individual working alone can be small, however together they are significant value to create major benefits and accomplishments.

APPENDIX · A

ST. MESROB ARMENIAN CHURCH PERMANENT TRUST FUND

Over the past 65 years the St. Mesrob Armenian Apostolic Church of Racine, Wisconsin has been blessed in many ways, particularly through the talents and resources of her members and most importantly by the generosity and financial gifting of funds. The donated and also generated funds have enable our community's wise leadership over the years to invest these funds sensibly in a secure fashion so as to ensure and assure the parish community to carry out all needful ministries encumbered in the Christian life.

Until the early 1970's these funds did not exist within a cohesive structure in order to properly execute their usages. Thus with the beginning of a new life on Erie Street in our new edifice, a Permanent Trust Committee was formally established, elected by the parish members to be the advisors, administrators and guardians of the officially established Permanent Trust Fund. The committee consists of three persons to serve for a three year period, re-electable.

During our fifteen years here at our present location the Permanent Trust Fund has grown with the addition of new donations within its structure added to the existing stocks, certificates of deposits, and bonds purchased over the 65 year history of our parish.

Because it has grown sizeably and has produced a rich financial increase and because new additions and donations are given for even a greater variety of uses, it is therefore necessary to put in writing a guideline for the committee and community, non-existant until now, to facilitate the proper government, administration and uses of these many funds.

The original intention of the Permanent Trust Fund was to use only the interest and <u>not</u> the principal amounts originally donated for 'emergency' purposes. It is the intention of this guideline to articulate with specificity and define with greater clarity the use of monies from the Permanent Trust Fund and the process of how to acquire these monies.

Aside from the Stocks, Bonds and CD's, there exist within the Permanent Trust Fund four special/memorial funds as follows:

- a) The Var Cherkinian Memorial Fund The interest from this donation is designated for use by the Church Sunday School. This fund was established in 1980.
- b) The Sahag Akgulian Memorial Fund The interest from this fund is to be used for educational purposes within the church vis a vis programs, seminars, workshops, etc. This was established in 1985.

- c) The Organ Fund (Special) The interest to be used for the preventive maintenance of the organ and any added appointments to it in future years. It was established in 1985.
- d) The Ardis Cherkinian Family Armenian Cultural Endowment Fund The interest of this fund is to be used for the programing of and
 presentations on Armenian Culture, music, arts, literature, etc.
 This fund was established in 1981.

These funds have been secured for the designated programs, honoring the wishes of the donors. Any parishioner is invited to establish such a fund as memorial or special (as designated) with an initial donation of \$1000.00 accompanied by a signatured and dated letter explaining the nature of the donation. After a fund of this nature is established, further amounts may be added to them thus increasing the annual rate of interest borne.

Aside from these memorial/special funds which exist are the other funds held particularly for use within the general parish community.

All interests and proceeds from these other assets shall be made available to be used for Capital Improvements and any emergency repairs to properties and other unknown emergency expenditures.

Process of Acquisition of Monies:

- a) Short Cash Flow in Parish Treasury:

 The Parish Council will be empowered to authorize the transfer of funds from the Permanent Trust Fund to the Parish Treasury whenever necessary in order to pay bills and retain the credit/integrity of our community. These funds shall be repaid to the Permanent Trust Fund within 6 months of the date borrowed.
- b) Repairs and Structural Improvements:
 For any Capital Improvement or Repair of the Church Structure, properties and owned dwelling, a special parish assembly must be called by the Parish Council in order that they receive from the church membership the authorization to obtain funds from the Permanent Trust Fund to cover expenses of the work.
- c) No stocks, bonds or any securities may be liquidated or terminated without the approval of the Parish Council and in agreement with Permanent Trust Committee members.
