Dear Friend:

It is a great pleasure to announce the formation of the Armenian Independent Cultural Association of Atlanta's Building Fund Committee.

At its March 6th meeting, the AICAA membership voted overwhelmingly to establish a Building Fund Committee. This will enable the Armenian community in Atlanta to begin a fundraising drive for a cultural center. Included in the plans for this cultural center are a kitchen, library, classroom, and meeting rooms.

In order for the Building Fund to succeed, it will take the dedication, cooperation, and support of all of us. One way in which you can contribute is through our Pledge Program. As a starting point, we suggest that families pledge \$2 per week to the Building Fund. Contributions can be paid on a monthly, quarterly, or lump-sum basis, and are tax-deductible. Of course, if you are able to contribute a greater amount, this will enable us to achieve our goal in less time.

We understand that everyone may not be in a position to contribute financially to the Building Fund. However, there are limitless other ways in which you can help make the Building Fund a success--volunteering at events, selling tickets, etc. The Committee also encourages you to offer any ideas or suggestions that you might have.

A kick-off banquet will be held at 7:00 PM Saturday evening, April 9, 1983 at St. Bede's Episcopal Church, 2601 Henderson Mill Rd., N.E. Atlanta, GA. Tickets are \$12 per person, \$6 for students and children 16 and under. Please complete the enclosed form and return to AICAA Building Fund Committee no later than April 6.

The Building Fund Committee has some ideas, enthusiasm, and energy, but we also need your help and support. Please do what you can to help this worthwhile project for ourselves and for the future generations of Armenians in Atlanta. IF WE WORK TOGETHER WE CAN -- AND WE WILL -- SUCCEED.
