ARCHBISHOP MANOOGIAN VISITS ATLANTA, GEORGIA: MAY 1, 1987

On Friday, May 1, 1987, His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, Primate of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America, will be celebrant for an Easter Service at the Morningside Presbyterian Church, 1411 North Morningside Drive, in Atlanta. The church service will commence at 7:30 p.m. The Reverend Father Vertanes Kalayjian of Washington, D.C. will accompany the Primate. This visit is part of the missionary efforts being made by the Armenian Diocese to establish an Armenian church parish in the Atlanta area.

Archbishop Manoogian has recently been acknowledged as a Statue of Liberty Medal recipient awarded by Mayor Koch on the occasion of the 100th Anniversary of the Statue of Liberty last July as well as a recipient of the Ellis Island Medal of Honor Award presented by the Statue of Liberty-Ellis Island Foundation on October 29, 1986 as a tribute to the nation's heritage of ethnic diversity.
