

***** ARMENIA WINTER RESCUE UPDATE *****

Dear Friends.

We have accomplished our goal, thanks to all of you who have participated in the "Armenia Winter Rescue Fund". So far we have almost one shipping container of winter clothing and about \$6,000 in cash contributions. In discussions with the Armenian Embassy it was indicated that at this time what is needed most is canned meat, powdered milk, medical and personal hygiene items. In the last meeting of the AICAA board of directors, it was decided to allocate half of the collected money to canned meat (Chicken or Tuna) and the other half to powdered milk. At this time we are busy with the proper arrangements for this shipment.

The collection of clothing is a major operation in several areas. Alabama has been most instrumental in collections thanks to Dr. Aris Merijanian and Gohar. So far Dr. Merijanian has delivered three truck loads of clothing to our collection center. These efforts have been with full support of Dawson Memorial Baptist church. Janet Kennedy of Gwinett county has mobilized a number of churches and other organizations in Gwinett county and there is a large collection for Armenia. Many thanks to Emily Matthews who has collected loads of clothing from the Norcross Cooperative Ministry. Also Mary Thompson has been instrumental in collecting a great deal of clothing for this operation. Many thanks to Kevork Yacoubian, who has secured a collection of antibiotics from Tennessee. At this time we are getting very close to sorting and boxing stage of our activities.

On Saturday, March 20, 1993, 9:00A.M.- 3:00 P.M., we will be in Gwinett county collecting and sorting clothing in the parking lot of the First Baptist Church of Norcross. On Sunday, March 21, starting at 10:00 A.M., we will be sorting and packing all the clothing collected so far, and loading the container for Armenia. We need your help for both days.



This will be a fun activity and if anyone wants to enclose messages from Atlanta Armenian community to our country men in Armenia, we can include them in the boxes. For directions and more information you can call Armen or Sonja Karapetian 518-4997, 518-4982; and please let them know what hours you are willing to help.
