

Shnorhali Fellowship Annual Report 1965

The calendar of events for 1965 included:

The calendar of events also included a social activity for each month but due to other circumstances these events did not take place.

In December (Dec. 9, 1965) a membership meeting was held and a temporary executive committee was elected for a period of three months.
