At the end of January the Superintendent's position was assumed by Dr. Charles Kumkumian. Up until that time the position was held by Yerstzgin Anahid Kalayjian, who had been Superintendent since 1879.

The Church School has an enrollment of 55 students. It covers students from Nursery to Eleventh Grade.

Church School starts at 10:30 a.m. and continues until 12 noon. The morning begins with an assembly which is conducted by Yeretzgin, with formal classes afterwards. The classes, teachers and staff are as follows:

On October 22, we had a Talent Night which brought out the many talents of our students. Finally on December 26 we had a Special Christmes Service, which followed the Divine Liturgy. During this past year we had a Faith and Method Workshop (November 13, 1982) sponsored by The Department of Religious Education.

We thank our teachers and staff for their time and dedication. In addition, we thank the Ladies' Guild for their donations and generous support. We also thank Der Hayr for his continuous assistance and support.

The Church School is an established teaching organization which joyfully and with love carries out its role. Parents who do not take advantage of the School and bring their children may later regret it.
