WE REGRET THE FACT THAT WE DID NOT HOLD MORE EVENTS OF A RELIGIOUS NATURE. WE DID TRY TO MAKE UP FOR THIS FACT BY PERFORMING OTHER CHRISTIAN ACTIVITIES.
