Dear Delegate:

We, as delegates, have the responsibility of representing our parishes at the annual Diocesan Assembly as well as guiding and helping the Diocese.

Please allow me to report on the progress of the Stewardship Program:

For the year 1991, \$12,353.96 was turned over to the Diocese.

To date, we have 53 Life Stewards and 118 Annual Stewards totaling 171 Stewards.

The goal is 250 Stewards by our next Diocesan Assembly in Florida and your help is being requested.

As delegates, we have asked for changes some of which have been made and more are on the way. But, its implementation will not be possible without our support. The Stewardship Program is one way of helping so that none of our suggestions and none of the necessary programs will suffer.

You can help by:

1. Becoming a Life Steward or
2. Becoming an Annual Steward, and
3. Recommending six families from your parish or friends who are likely candidates for stewardship. We will then ask them to join the Diocesan Stewardship family.

The Diocese is trying to find solutions to the difficult problems it faces, and needs our help, as I need your help in making the Stewardship program successful.

The goal of the 250 Stewards will not be reached without everyone's help; therefore, please give me the "leads" on the enclosed form and I will do the writing.

"We got high marks in 1991 and together we will set new marks in 1992."
