Dear Miss Berberian:

Thank you for your prompt answer to our letter and the gracious way you handled the situation.

We apologize for the inconvenience caused by our reminder and we believe you deserve an explanation.

We took your name from a list sent to us recently by the Philadelphia Committee together with a letter indicating that the amounts against the names (about 30) were the only ones they could not collect. This, naturally, led us to believe that they had received a negative answer from everyone of them.

From the cancelled checks you kindly sent us, we see that the first \$100.- was paid to the Committee and the last \$100.- directly to us. Two years ago, we had no way of knowing that this payment was part of a pledge made in Philadelphia, therefore we entered it in our files against your name and sent you our receipt. The end result is the same, but it does not justify the inconvenience.

We only hope that there won't be other cases like this because not many people are as understanding and what's more as gracious as you.
