We will refer to a Serebend type hand woven rug, 4.11 x 3.5 feet, we examined at your premises. Your stock No 10331.

According to an original label as sewn on the back of the rug, it was "Made by the Armenian girls in Ghazir (Syria) orphanage of the Near East Relief".

The above mentioned orphanage, established and ruh by the American charitable organization The Near East Relief, dates back to the first World War. It was organized in order to take care of the many orphaned children, the parents of whom was massacred by the Turks. It is therefor safe to assume that this particular ryg was made during the years 1915-1918.

This is a good looking rug, in excellent condition. Aside from its value in todays market for older rugs of this type, this rug has also an intrisic, and I would add, a historical value as well, due to its unique background. There are very few of these rugs to be found now.

I would appraise its value at Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000,00).
