Following your letter of August 9th, I wrote you a letter, and now I am writing to inform you that I have shipped 500 copies of my book, "The Adventures of an Armenian boy" by Railway Express Agency, prepaid. I am sure you will receive them in a few days. They are insured for \$4000.00, which is as you know the value of the books. This is my cost of production four years ago when every thing was much cheaper. As you will see, the books can not be produced at twice as much to day. Therefore they should not be sold for less than my cost. \$8.00 a piece. This sum I am happy to donate to the church of my people. And if there would be any enthusiasm shown, I would consider donating more next year. It seems that once an Armenian, one will always be an Armenian. Older I get, warmer my feeling get for my people. I hope the sale of the books will be success which will help the church, and make our young people more conscious of their past heritage, and sufferings of their parents for the church and unity, tradition of our nation.
