Dear Hratch;

After receiving your letter, I did hear from Bishop  
Torkom Manoogian from New York. I shipped him yesterday 500 copies  
of my books by Railway Express Agency, prepaid, so that they would not  
have any trouble in receiving it. I hope he will write me a letter of  
receipt and thanks, as soon as he receives it. I wrote on the envelope  
that the books should be numbered 1500 and on up to 2000. I have been numbering  
all the books I have given away. If they number theirs, it will avoid confusion.

He wrote to me that they would be sold for \$8.00 a piece. Of course  
now it is theirs, since I have given them as a gift, but I still wish that they  
should be sold for the benefit of the church, and as a respect to me. The people  
will not appreciate anything given to them free, and these books are too nice  
to be thrown around. Besides that as I told you they cost me \$8.00 a piece, when  
printing books were much cheaper then, in 1964. Now they could not be replaced  
at that price. If there is any call for the books, and they sell them as stated  
I would consider to give them more next year as further donation. We will see  
what will happen.

I see you got acquainted with Jacobs in Lansing. He told me  
he could not do any business with you because you were another too clever  
Armenian. Well that is the way it goes. Any way it is nice to know people.  
I hope everything is well with you, and your family.
