Dear Mr. Kavookjian:

By my letter of May 21, 1971, I advised you that I had transferred 100 shares of Survival Technology to the account of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America with Burnham and Company as a donation towards my pledge as the Godfather of the Bema stone. I am advised that pursuant to your instructions the 100 shares were sold the same day for \$2,700.00 and after the deduction of commissions, etc., you should receive the net amount of \$2,647.50.

Burnham and Company mailed the check to the order of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America for that amount. However, due to an error in our office it was deposited in the account of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America Loan and Grant Fund.

Enclosed you will find check No. 18, dated June 1, 1971, of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America Loan and Grant Fund to the order of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America to refund the amount erroneously deposited by the Loan and Grant Fund.

Enclosed you will also find my check to the order of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America for \$1,352.50, so that the net amount received towards my pledge by reason of the gift of the stock and the last mentioned check will be \$4,000., leaving an unpaid balance of \$2,000.00.
